### **Pediatric Blood and Marrow Transplant Consortium Young Investigator Award and Travel Stipend**

The PBMTC has established the Young Investigator Travel Award and Travel Stipend to encourage education, mentoring and leadership of young investigators in pediatric SCT.

#### **The qualifications for the award candidates are as follows:**

- Completion of your fellowship after June 30, 2008
- The individual has conducted high-quality clinical or laboratory research on a project (described in the abstract) in which he or she participated actively in the design, conduct, and data analysis.

#### **To apply, please submit the following:**

- An abstract submitted with the young investigator designated as the first author.
- Please submit the following documents to Laura Hancock at [lhancock@chla.usc.edu](mailto:lhancock@chla.usc.edu).
  - The candidate's curriculum vitae.
  - A supporting letter from the training program director or clinical or laboratory mentor attesting to the fact that the Young Investigator Award nominee has played a major if not the key role in the conduct of the research project and confirming the candidate's promise as a young investigator in pediatric HSCT transplant.

*Winners are chosen by evaluation of abstracts submitted for presentation at the PBMTC Conference, together with review of each candidate's other research contributions and application materials.*

#### **Notes:**

- This abstract *must* be submitted to PBMTC's Call for Abstracts and you must select the check box for the International Investigator to be eligible.
- Abstract must be submitted by **Tuesday, January 15, 2019**.
- All award application materials must be received by Laura Hancock ([lhancock@chla.usc.edu](mailto:lhancock@chla.usc.edu)) no later than **Tuesday, January 15, 2019**.
